Mr. Hopkins was not in attendance but did notify the Board of the following repairs:

- The beacon light lamp is scheduled to be replaced.
- The gate at the end of Nanway Boulevard is now operative.
- A heater was replaced at the airport lighting vault.

Airport Engineer (Mark Vilem)

FAA Issues

Engineer Vilem and President Lucas shared issues of concern expressed by the FAA during a recent telephone meeting regarding the proposed north taxiway and an issue with a building or hangar construction on the north side of the airport.

1. A proposed building construction on the north side

The Board discussed the proposed interest in the construction of a hangar or building and how it relates to the Airport Authority and taxiway access if a hangar or building is constructed.

2. Discussion on Through-the-fence Agreements

The FAA questioned if there were any through-the-fence (TTF) agreements with those tenants on the northside of the airport. Engineer Vilem explained that the FAA funds projects in which the airport benefits, but not for private entities.

The Board will prepare a presentation scheduled for the next FAA meeting on 11/17 to include the following facts relative to northside entity of Portage Airport Condominium Association (PACA).

- 1. Both partial and full designs for the north taxiway service airport owned and operated hangers.
- 2. The TTF operators/owners have deeded access to the airport and runway
- 3. The TTF operators/owners, as recorded in the plat/deed, must comply with the rules and regulations of the Portage County Airport
- 4. The TTF operators/owners, as recorded in the plat/deed, must only use the property for storage of aircraft and aircraft operations.
- 5. The TTF operators/owners have contributed land valued at \$45,000 to complete the taxiway project.
- 6. The TTF operators/owners pay user fees in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Portage County Airport

President Lucas will advise the members of the upcoming meeting times to develop the presentation and Capital Improvement Plan priority list.

Care Act Grant

President Lucas signed the final papers and Engineer Vilem expects funding to become available within the week.

Jet A Tank Replacement

President Lucas was informed that a delay in the contractor's installation of the new tank moved to the week of November 16, 2020; Mr. Lucas intends on contacting the contractor to stress the urgency in this matter to perhaps have an earlier installation date.

Meeting with County Officials (Roberts, Bennet, Brag)

The Board awaits feedback from the Portage County Officials relative to its last meeting about the current and future airport financial condition.
